


Christmas Open House at Fort Harrison (see

The Dayton community is invited to participate in the ceremony or just be present as we honor our hometown heroes. Volunteers are needed to present the wreaths on each individual grave. Last year, we placed 152 wreaths in the cemetery. If you are aware of a veteran buried in the cemetery who did not receive a wreath last year, please contact us at fortharrisonva@gmail.com so we can include them this year. ALL VETERANS, whether their service was during wartime or not, are eligible to have a wreath placed on their grave.


## Saturday, November 9 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Growing up on an early family homestead, Page County native Clyde Jenkins was surrounded by the 18th and 19th century ways of doing things. One of his favorite subjects is old Shenandoah Valley apple varieties, and he works hard to protect and share them.

Mr. Jenkins will bring a selection of his personal favorites to Fort Harrison for a tasting on November 9 and shares stories about them and explain his grafting techniques. He will also have trees on hand to sell; when you find an apple you especially like, you can purchase a sapling.

Mr. Jenkins believes many Valley heirloom varieties are already gone and laments the loss of diverse flavors and textures that were once so much a part of Valley life.

A fundraiser for Fort Harrison, the cost for participating is \$10 per person.







